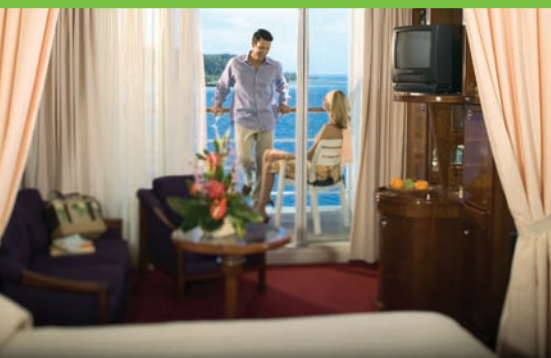

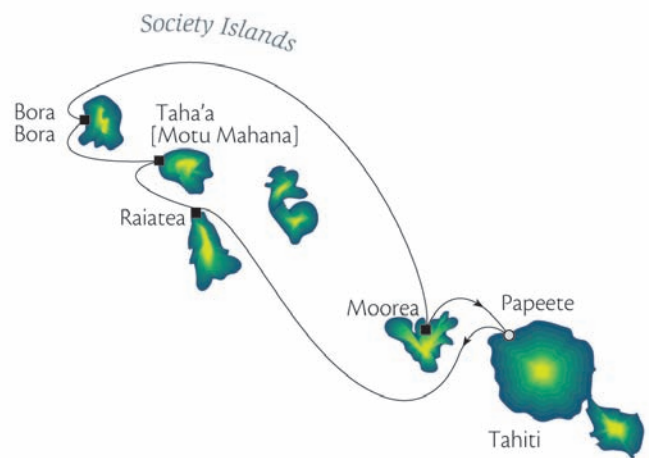

This 7-night itinerary is perfect for those who want a core Polynesian experience. The Society Islands are what your daydreams are made of: crystal-clear waters, pristine beaches, and lush mountains that leap almost vertically from turquoise lagoons.

Port Highlights:

Raiatea - Also known as Sacred Hava'i, Raiatea is home to one of the most venerated temples in all of Polynesia, the Marae Taputapuata. Let the spray of waterfalls cool your cheeks on a hike through the island's interior, explore untouched forests of bamboo and balsawood, and snorkel among beds of rare pearl oysters on the island's beautiful reef.

Taha'a (Motu Mahana) - An uninhabited islet off the coast of Taha'a, Motu Mahana is Paul Gauguin's exclusive private retreat. Here you are free to do as you please — relax in shade of palm trees on the white sand beach, unwind to the songs of the Gauguines, or snorkel the motu's turquoise lagoons, working up an appetite for a delectable al fresco barbecue feast.

Bora Bora - Graced with crystalline aqua lagoons, idyllic white-sand beaches, jagged volcanic peaks, Bora Bora appears like a postcard as you arrive. Circle the island by wave runner or jet boat, traverse the interior by off-road safari, dive beneath the surface for a chance to swim with reef fish, moray eels, and lemon sharks, or relax on the exclusive, private beach on a motu just off the island.

**Special group rate for the Professional Education Society

Fares are per person, based on double occupancy and include FREE roundtrip economy class airfare from Los Angeles to Tahiti. Air credit of \$1,450 for cruise only. Government fees, port, handling, and security charges are \$14 per person.

Pre-cruise flight arrangements include a April 20 overnight flight from Los Angeles to Papeete with a hotel day-room use upon arrival and afternoon transfer to the ship. Post-cruise flight arrangements include a city tour, hotel day-room use and transfer to the airport for an overnight flight with arrival back in Los Angeles on April 29.

Air deviations can be requested. There is a \$100 per person charge along with any fare difference that may apply. Transfers and hotel day-room use are not valid on the dates deviated.

CONTINUING EDUCATION RECOGNITION AWARDS

Tax Deduction

This travel seminar in French Polynesia has been designed to comply with current IRS convention rules and deductibility requirements under Code Section 274(h)(1) as directly related to the conduct of the attendee's profession and meeting the reasonableness standard of the foreign seminar rules. The formal meetings will be scheduled with lectures and discussions. Seminars in conference rooms, clinics or hospitals will be conducted by foreign speakers as well as distinguished members of the Professional Education Society.

Documentation verifying the scheduling dates, locations, hours of attendance, certificate of participation, and appropriate certificate of continuing medical, dental or nursing education will be provided at the completion of the conference. Consult your tax advisor for detailed information concerning deductibility of expenses related to your particular situation.

Physicians: This program has been reviewed and is acceptable for up to 15 prescribed hours by the American Academy of Family Physicians.

Dentists: The Professional Education Society, as provider, is authorized to confer up to 15 hours of California Continuing Education credit units and 15 FAGD/MAGD credit hours with the Academy of General Dentistry. The Professional Education Society is an ADA CERP Recognized Provider.
